Grade 8 Visual Art *3-D Paper Sculpture Flowers*

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results: Folded Origami Paper Flowers

Content Knowledge: Paper cutting and paper folding

Vocabulary: origami

Skills: Paper folding, following visual sequential directions, gluing and holding glued objects in place until glue dries.

Expectation Students will watch the tutorial on the folding of 6 different origami paper flowers. Students are expected to make six folded origami flowers and may make six of the same flower, but are highly encouraged to make one of each of the six different flower designs.

Day 1: Students will watch the video. Students will gather their materials: papers, scissors, glue and stapler	YouTube video- 6 Easy Paper Flowers Flower Making DIY (link posted in Google Classroom)	Students should have all materials ready to begin.
Day 2: Students will follow the video and will choose the first flower they wish to construct. Students will construct one flower.	YouTube video- 6 Easy Paper Flowers Flower Making DIY (link posted in Google Classroom)	Students will construct one flower.
Day 3: Students will construct their second and third flower.	YouTube video- 6 Easy Paper Flowers Flower Making DIY (link posted in Google Classroom)	Students will construct two more flowers (Three total)
Day 4: Students will construct their fourth and fifth flower.	YouTube video- 6 Easy Paper Flowers Flower Making DIY (link posted in Google Classroom)	Students will construct two more flowers. (five total)
Day 5: Students will construct their sixth flower. Students will then photograph each flower and will upload each flower into	YouTube video- 6 Easy Paper Flowers Flower Making DIY (link posted in Google Classroom)	Students will construct one more flower. (six total)
