Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge: K1. Plus-que-parfait **K2** Passé simple (regular and irregular) **K3.** Demonstrative pronouns (he who): celui, ceux, celle, celles, etc. **K4.** demonstrative adjectives - ce, cet, cette, ces. **K5.** Voca associated with francophone fables. **K6.** Ongoing knowledge of passé composé and imparfait (regular and irregular). **K7.** fables and their structure.

Vocabulary: Recycled use of unit vocabulary.

Skills: S1. Reading and interpreting texts at the intermediate level. **S2.** Deciding between the past tenses in context, such as talking about their personal past or francophone fables. **S5.** Using demonstrative pronouns correctly in context. **S6.** Using demonstrative adjectives correctly in context. **S7.** Communicating basic information about francophone fables while incorporating associated vocabulary. **S8.** Interpreting fables and using their structure in your own writing.

Expectation: Students will be introduced to the passé simple for both regular and irregular verbs. They will be able to recognize some of the verbs from the Fables. The goal is for students to be able to 1) recognize this literary past tense and be able to convert verbs in the passé simple to the passé composé.
