Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge:

Vocabulary: Plagiarism; Works Cited

Skills:

- When using other people's ideas or words, you need to give them credit by citing their works.
- Cite print/website content when used as a resource.

Expectation: Students will know when it is appropriate and necessary to give credit to other people's ideas. Students will be able to use a tool to help them create a works cited document.
