Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge:

Vocabulary: internal struggle, external struggles, conflict, compare and contrast, **vowel patterns**

Skills:

- Identify internal and external struggles of characters.
- Explain how historical events shape the perspectives of people during that time.
- Compare and contrast characters experiences.
- **Some words have a vowel pattern with one or two vowels and r. When vowels are with the r in words, usually sounds will blend to modify the vowel sound.**

Expectation: This week students will continue to read historical fiction while thinking about the character's perspective and struggles throughout the American Revolution.
