Grade 8 ART Elective - *Fun with Photography*

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge: Students will use photography to design an interesting composition.

Vocabulary: Composition, positive/negative space, cropping, abstract, realistic

Skills: using different functions on a camera

Expectation: Students will select 3 objects that make them think of summer vacation and create an interesting way of using these objects in a photograph.
