### Grade 8 Library Media - Citing videos in Noodletools, Exporting bibliography from Noodletools

#### Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Students will know how to cite a video from YouTube; Students will know how to export and share their finished bibliography

**Content Knowledge:** Students will access a video to use for their SS research and cite a video in Noodletools into their project bibliography

**Vocabulary:** Citation: Provides readers with the title, publisher, producer, date and how to find the resources.  
Bibliography: A list of citations - list of the resources you used for the project

**Skills:** Analyzing a video to determine its title, creator, producer, and the date it was published.

**Expectation:** Each student will successfully cite a video in their SS bibliography

Students will select a video they have used in their Social Studies research, or select one provided and cite it in Noodletools.
