Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge: Students will know the name and location of various landmarks on the human body, including but not limited to: cephalic, frontal, orbital, nasal, buccal, oral, cervical, thoracic, sternal, axillary, abdominal, umbilical, pelvic, inguinal, pubic, deltoid, brachial, antecubital, carpal, digital, etc.

Vocabulary: anatomical position, supine, prone, superior, inferior, posterior, anterior, medial, lateral, proximal, distal, sagittal, coronal, frontal, and transverse.

Skills: Create a website that correctly uses medical terminology and that can be used as a reference for others to learn about the interdependence of body systems.
