## Visual Art: Darkroom Photography- *Wide Open Aperture*

### Targeted Goals from Stage 1:

#### Content Knowledge:

Aperture controls Depth of Field, Pre-set, camera functions are shortcuts for manual aperture and shutter speed settings

**Vocabulary:** Aperture, Selective Focus vs. Extensive Depth of Field, Macro, Preset (Creative) vs. Manual camera settings

**Skills:** Students will apply knowledge of the principles and elements of design to compose interesting photos from unique viewpoints. The photos will utilize a wide open aperture, using A or AV manual setting or the flower and portrait preset mode.
