Targeted Goals from Stage 1:

Pre-Production: Identify and practice the complex elements of pre-production to effectively deliver a message.

Content Knowledge:

- Video Treatment Process

Vocabulary:

- Video Metaphor: Representational Ideas vs literal ideas
- “Green Light” Video Treatment Process

Skills: Plan and Convey a complex video message that expresses meaning using a representational idea as opposed to a literal idea.

Expectation: Students will write and propose a metaphorical or representational idea which conveys a complex message with the intent of filming it the following week.
