Grade 7 Health: *Advertising, Alcohol, & Marijuana*

Content Knowledge: Tobacco advertising became restricted once the harmful and addictive effects of nicotine were discovered. Unfortunately, generations of people became addicted, and now e-cigarettes are trying to sell their products using the same types of advertising. Drugs can be both helpful and harmful, depending on how they are used. All drugs have side effects, and some side effects are actually useful for some conditions, but other side effects can be very serious. Drugs that are legal for medical use often require a doctor's permission to be obtained. Marijuana is only legal in CT for certain medical conditions and it requires a doctor's permission. All other uses of marijuana are illegal in our state.

Vocabulary: Tobacco, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes, vaping, Surgeon General's Warning, advertising, Marijuana, THC, CBD, vape, smoke, medical use, alcohol, short-term, long-term, physical effect, psychological effect, dopamine, addiction, depressant, CBD, THC, psychoactive

Skills: Recognize that tobacco companies are not honest and they manipulate people using a variety of advertising strategies. Recognize that there are different laws in different states and countries regarding marijuana use, identify the factors that make marijuana use for teens more harmful with more permanent damage on the brain, identify that medical use of marijuana can provide relief for certain conditions. Recognize that alcohol is a legal drug that many adults use responsibly, identify reasons why alcohol use is harmful for teens, identify the harmful effects of alcohol on teenage brains.
