Targeted Goals from Stage 1:

- Production: Identify and describe the elements of production to effectively deliver a message.
- Describe the various types of sound equipment and techniques used with handheld, lavalier, shotgun microphones and methods.

Content Knowledge: Successful video production requires a thorough attention to the complex details of capturing a moment: color, exposure, focus adjustments as well as camera stabilization.

Vocabulary:

- Sequencing: continuity, cutaways, 5 second rule, jump cuts, Shot sequence, scenes, 180 degree rule and pacing.
- Audio Editing: Overlap, L Edits, J Edits, and U Edits or “Cutaways”

Skills:

- Combine audio and video production editing techniques to enable audio overlapping.
- Produce a “Conversation Sequence” video from the storyboard you created in the previous week that conveys dialogue with overlapping audio.
