Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Vocabulary: science and medicine vocabulary

Skills: **S1.** Using the conditional (w/si clauses) to discuss hypothetical situations. **S2.** Distinguishing between the uses and intricacies of the active vs. passive voice. **S3.** Reading and interpreting texts (and audios) at the intermediate level. **S4.** Comparing and contrasting practices, products and perspectives with their own. **S5** Presenting summaries of current events or authentic literature related to science and technology (modern medicine). **S6.** Working individually or collaboratively to complete an important objective or task. **S7.** Deciding between c'est and il est in context (to be used in script + email)

Expectation: Students will begin to transition from vocabulary and discussion about science and technology to that of science and medical advancements and medical technology.
