Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Students continue to build their skills on their chosen instrument as well as their appreciation for music.

Content Knowledge: Evaluate and refine personal performance, individually or in collaboration with others (virtually)

Vocabulary: Articulations, Dynamics, Style, Character

Skills: Score reading, Music Analyzation, Practice Skills

Expectation: Students should spend at least 15-20 minutes playing their instruments. Although the students need to practice to build their skills on their instrument, practicing an instrument in between their work in their other classes, keeps the brain active, allowing for better absorption and understanding of new material.

Description of Task (s):	Resources and Materials: (Internet Access, Instrument, concert repertoire)	Daily Checks (Return to Google Classroom or snapshots from a cell phone)
Monday: Students will listen/watch a recording of “Ghosts of Brandenburg” by Richard Meyer on YouTube. The recording contains the score that the students can follow along with. Students should also have their sheet music out to make any marks in regards to style, articulations, dynamics, or character. Tuesday - Friday: Each day, using the rehearsal numbers to break the piece into manageable sections, work through “Ghosts of Brandenburg” by Richard Meyer.
