<p>Mozart Active Listening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Answer a few questions about tempo, dynamics, mood, instrumentation, lyrics, and texture (refer to the active listening guide)- Choose a song from a bank of Mozart's music- Students will draw what they hear (this can be shapes and lines or it can be a scene they think would go with it)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Active listening guide- Links to pieces of music	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Picture of their music drawing- Google form for answering the elements of music
